Global lock-downs, mass inflation, and collapsing economies around the world have highlighted more than ever the need for decentralized systems and human privacy.

Through all of this, Detroit Blockchain Center has remained absolute in its commitment to drive the Decentralized Future forward through education, inspiration, and innovation.



Through past activities, ensure DBC is self-sufficient financially & staffing




